DACC REOPENS CAMPUS MONDAY, JULY 6, 2020

As the State of Illinois enters Phase 4 of the Governor's Reopen plan, Danville Area Community College is committed to providing students, staff, and visitors with a safe and healthy learning environment.

Beginning Monday, July 6, 2020, DACC will reopen campus operations and will resume normal business. College employees will report for their regularly scheduled hours and offices will resume regular summer business hours. Summer business hours are **7:30 am to 4:30 pm, Monday through Thursday, and 7:30 am to 4:00 pm Friday.** This schedule applies to both the Main Street, Danville, campus and Hoopeston Higher Learning Center.

Based on a plan developed by CART (COVID Action Response Team), a College-wide committee of Faculty and Staff, the College will implement procedures to safeguard students, employees, and visitors:

- ◆ **All Students, Employees, and Visitors are required to pass through a Health Checkpoint as they enter Campus buildings.**

Each building has one open entry door. Checkpoints are located in the entry foyer of each building. Checkpoints assess temperature, confirm face covering, and ask health questions before admitting anyone to the building. Masks will be provided for anyone who does not have one. Anyone may be asked to leave campus for refusal or non-compliance.

- ◆ **All Students, Employees, and Visitors are required to wear face coverings in public areas and any classrooms where social distancing is not possible.**

Plexiglas has been installed in offices that require face-to-face transactions. Social-distancing will be maintained at entranceways and hallways with X's that are six feet apart along the floor for students and visitors waiting in line.

- ◆ **All Students, Employees, and Visitors need to pass a temperature check in order to be permitted on Campus.**

Checkpoints assess temperature using a No-Touch thermometer. To be approved for entry, people need to have a temperature that is **100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or lower.**

Anyone whose temperature is above 100.5 will not be admitted onto the Campus. Students will need to inform their professor if they are not approved for campus access.

Security will keep a record of those not approved for entry at the checkpoint.

- ◆ **All Students, Employees, and Visitors who are admitted onto Campus will be required to display an admissions sticker on their clothing.**

This grants access only for the date that appears on the sticker.

- ◆ **All Students, Employees, and Visitors are encouraged to use refillable containers rather than drinking straight from public drinking fountains.**

Free refillable water bottles are available in each campus building for anyone who does not have one.
