## **Transfer Admission Requirements:**

- 1. A GPA of 3.20 on a 4.0 scale is required.
- 2. An average of only 12-15 transfer students per year are admitted into this program.
- 3. Transfer students are admitted for Fall term only.
- 4. MATH 120 as well as MATH 130 or PHYS 101 must be **successfully** completed before the desired term of entry. Students considering Building Structure or Structural Engineering should take MATH 130. All other students should take PHYS 101.
- 5. Transfer students must also be able to meet the UIUC's **freshman** admission requirements (H.S. Course Pattern, ACT/SAT scores, and H.S. Class Rank).

## **Notes:**

- 1. Three years of one foreign language at the high school level or three levels in college are required for this program.
- 2. If foreign language requirement is met, you may substitute general education electives and take them during the second and third semesters in place of the foreign language elective. You must have 18 hours of general education electives.
- 3. Credit for college algebra and/or trigonometry completed in college as preparation for Calculus and Analytic Geometry I will **not** apply toward the degree requirements.
- 4. Starting in 2018, UIUC requires students to complete one course in Non-Western Cultures (NW), one course in U.S. Minority Cultures (US), and one course in Western/Comparative Cultures (WCC). Courses that can be taken at DACC to meet these requirements are SOCY 225, POLI 240, ANTH 103, HIST 122, LITR 111, HIST 111, HIST 112, HIST 151, HIST 152, LITR 121, and LITR 122.
