### **Transfer Admission Requirements:**

1. 2.50 GPA (4.0 scale).
2. Students must apply for admission to ISU and also complete an online School of Art application. Please refer to [www.finarts.illinoisstate.edu/art/](http://www.finarts.illinoisstate.edu/art/).
3. All Art Courses must be grades of C or better. Art Education majors must have a C or better in all education courses as well.
4. Successful portfolio review. Students should keep all art work to assemble their portfolio. For more information regarding the portfolio requirements, access the Illinois State website. Art History majors submit a Statement of Interest in lieu of a portfolio.

### **Notes:**

1. ARTS 119, 117, and 120 directly articulate as ISU. ARTS 103, 104 and 109.
2. A minimum grade of B is required for Art History majors in ARTS 111 and ARTS 112 (Art History I and Art History II).
3. Students can meet ISU's AMALI (cultures and traditions of Asian, the Middle East, Africa, Latin American or Indigenous Peoples of the world) graduation requirement by completing POLI 160, POLI 240, or GEOG 134 as a DACC social science requirement. If a different social science elective is completed, the AMALI requirement must be met at ISU. There are dozens of courses to choose from in this area once the student is enrolled at ISU. Art History majors will meet this requirement once they transfer to ISU by taking their ART 275 World Arts: Visual Arts course which is a requirement in the Art History major.
4. Completion of Foreign Language Level III (103) is required for the B.A. All B.S. degree students must complete an additional science, math, or technology course beyond the general education requirements.
5. Art Education majors should take POLI 150 and PSYC 100. Art History Majors should take HIST 111 and HIST 112.
6. Art Education majors must also take EDUC 211 (Educational Psychology), and complete the TAP/Basic Skills Test exam in reading, writing, and mathematics **at ISU prior to transferring.**
7. Graphic Design: Students should complete ART 151 GD 1 in 3<sup>rd</sup> semester, and ART 152 GD 2 in 4<sup>th</sup> semester. Although currently the ART 152 is articulating as a major elective, we will substitute it for ISU ART 227 GD 2.
8. Art Teacher Education: Students might take ART 122 which articulates as ISU ART 213 Life Drawing (this fulfills a requirement in the Art Teacher Ed curriculum) or Art 130 Sculpture 1 which can fulfill an additional elective in the curriculum
