1. 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale).

Notes:

1. Radio and Television majors must complete ENGL 101 and 102 (Rhetoric & Composition I and II) by the end of the sophomore year with a grade of B or better in order to take advanced courses in the major. A grade in either of these courses lower than a B mandates that the student take an advanced composition course and pass with a grade of C or better.
2. Six Specializations: Digital Media Arts and Animation, Electronic Journalism, Media Industries, Radio/Audio, Electronic Sports Media, and TV/Video Production.
3. Must complete two college semesters of a foreign language.
4. Radio, Television, and Digital Media majors are recommended to take LITR 105 as one of their electives.
5. DACC recommends a three-hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science.
6. If a student transfers in without an AA or AS, the student must complete two (2) Humanities and one (1) Fine Arts in order to satisfy SIU's core curriculum.
