1. 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale).

Notes:

1. At SIU, 2 semesters of college foreign language is required of all students in the College of LAS. This is equivalent to 2 years of one foreign language in high school, but SIU requires that a proficiency exam be passed if 2 semesters are not completed at the college level.
2. DACC recommends a three-hour course in Multicultural Diversity, either in Humanities or Social Science. Options include: LITR 106, PHIL 104, ANTH 107, MUSI 120, SOCY 225, SOCY 200.
3. Humanities courses: PHIL 101, PHIL 102, PHIL 103, LITR 122, HUMN 101.
4. Fine Arts courses: ARTS 111, ARTS 112, ARTS 115, LITR 105, MUSI 115, MUSI 124, MUSIC 125.
5. Life Science courses: BIOL 100, BIOL 101, BIOL 102, BIOL 104, BIOL 105.
6. Physical Science courses: CHEM 100, CHEM 101, PHYS 101, PHYS 114, PHYS 143.
